

Kennedy Trust Scholarship – 2010

This scholarship has been established by the Kennedy Educational Scholarship Trust to assist a master's (by thesis) student at one of the Universities in New Zealand, to undertake research in a particular area of relevance to the Gas Industry.

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the Kennedy Trust Scholarship.
2. CAENZ will act as the agent for the Kennedy Trust Scholarship with regards selecting and monitoring the scholarship recipient.
3. One Scholarship shall normally be awarded for 2010.
4. The scholarship shall be tenable for one year only.
5. To be eligible a candidate shall be a graduate of a New Zealand University.
6. The Scholarship is tenable by a student who is a New Zealand citizen.
7. The basis of selection will be academic achievement, based on GPA as well as the proposed course of study and potential to contribute to the industry and/or society in their chosen field.
8. The value of the Scholarship is \$7,000.
9. The Scholarship may be held with any other scholarship, bursary, prize or tertiary allowance provided that the rules of those awards so permit. Students will be encouraged to apply for a TEC Enterprise Scholarship.
10. The Trustees of the Kennedy Educational Scholarship Trust shall appoint the Selection Committee, which shall comprise one trustee and two nominations from CAENZ. It shall be chaired by the trustee. Except as specified by the regulations the Selection Committee may regulate its own procedures.
11. The Scholarship shall be awarded by CAENZ upon the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
12. The CAENZ may terminate the Scholarship on receipt of a report from the appropriate Head of Department (or equivalent) at the University where the student is studying, that a student is not complying with all University rules and regulations.
13. Progress payments will be made to the successful candidate upon receipt of evidence that all conditions relating to the award have been satisfied, on completion of the literature review and 'field work'. Final payment on satisfactory completion of thesis.
14. Applications for the award are to be made on the appropriate form obtainable from CAENZ and forwarded to CAENZ. Applications may be made at any time until filled for tenure in 2010 and may extend into 2011.
